Photoshop Text Wrapping If you want your text to look a certain way, use Crop and then Rotate. It can also be used to make text fit within specific areas of a picture.

Adding Text to Pictures Adding text to an image in Photoshop is simple enough. Open the Text Tool and type your text in. Press the space bar to place your cursor, then place your text where you'd like it. Then press Ctrl + C (and if you're using a Mac, press Command + C) to copy your text to the clipboard. Go back to the image where you want your text to appear. If you haven't already installed any fonts, you'll need to do that. Go to the Windows and Mac installers for a list of compatible fonts. To add your text to the image, open the new layer and just drag it on top of the image. This technique works best for short texts like headlines. But if you want to add a lot of text, you can also create a text layer that you copy and paste your text onto.

Importing Text to an Image As soon as you create a new document, Photoshop opens the Type Tool. You can either type directly on the canvas or by using the marquee tool (command+M). In most cases, you'll end up with a paragraph of text. You can edit your text, or you can simply ignore it. To add your text to an image, you have to create a new layer, then add it to the layer you want it to appear. You'll still need to paste it in, which is easy enough. You can also import text from another source. You can take a separate document, such as a Word document, and paste the text into the document. You can also use another program to create the text file and then use the text import command in Photoshop.

Paste an Image into Another Image Another way to add an image to an image is to use a photo strip. You can also use a flash card. This is useful for adding text and graphics to a picture, or if you're using Photoshop for a Web site. Adobe's Web site has information on how to create one. The most basic kind of photo strip is just a collection of images in an image bin. This is similar to how you would browse a
